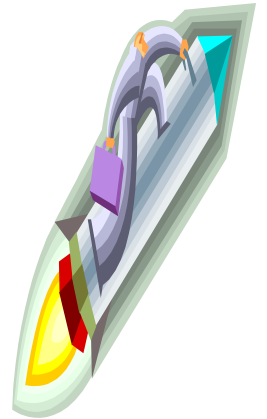
Story boards may be purchased from the office for \$4.00. We encourage all students to participate in this
