## After-school Chats

"What's in your backpack?" Greet your child with this question, and you'll discover a lot about what s(he) does in class.

- Set aside time each day to go through his/her papers. Try to do it first thing after school when their day is fresh in their mind.
- Look over your youngster's work together. Help them feel proud by pointing out something specific that they did nicely. For instance, if they show a picture of your family, you might say, "I like how you drew your brother playing chess and your little sister with pigtails."
- Have them talk through math problems or science experiments to show you what they have learned. She might explain how they find the perimeter of a triangle or why ants dig tunnels, for example.

**Important 2011-2012 Information**

- **ARRIVAL:** Buses begin to pick up at 6:30 A.M. Buses drop off at school at 7:15 A.M.
- **BEGIN SCHOOL:** The first bell rings at 7:40 A.M. The tardy bell rings at 7:45 A.M. **PARENTS MUST ACCOMPANY A CHILD TO THE OFFICE WHEN TARDY.**
- **STUDENT DRESS CODE:** All students are required to wear school uniforms each day unless specifically instructed differently by the principal. Shirts must be white or navy blue. Pants or shorts must be khaki or navy blue. Skirts and shorts should be of a length that when a student's arms are extended downward by the side in a natural position, the length of the skirt, shorts, etc. must be as long as the longest fingertip. Flip-flops are not considered proper shoes. Please refer to pages 21-22 for a copy of the complete dress code.
- **FOOD SERVICES:** Breakfast is served from 7:20 to 7:40 A.M. Your child must be at school between these times in order to eat breakfast.

- **BIRTHDAYS & HEALTHY SNACKS:** Students are not allowed to have birthday parties at school, but a parent may **arrange** to bring healthy treats to the class at **recess**. Only nutritious snacks may be brought to eat during recess. All drinks must be 100% juice, no carbonated soft drinks allowed. - **DISMISSAL:** Bus riders, car riders, and walkers are dismissed at 2:25 P.M.
- **CAR RIDERS:** Parents picking up children in their cars should remain in their vehicles until your child is brought out to you.
- **EARLY CHECKOUTS:** Our instructional day is from 7:45 A.M. to 2:25 P.M. We do not want students to miss valuable instructional time, homework assignments, or afternoon announcements. Please do not check out your child early unless it is absolutely necessary. **NO STUDENTS WILL BE CHECKED OUT AFTER 1:45 P.M.**
