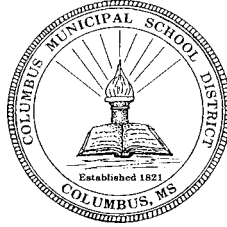


Columbus Municipal School District School Uniform Policy and Profile



School Uniform Policy

The Board of Trustees approved the following policy for clothing to be worn by all students in grades K-8 in the Columbus Municipal School District.

- 1) Uniforms as defined are meant to be color-coordinated clothing.
- 2) The following regulation will be followed for shirts / tops:
 - a) Shirts / tops must be white or navy blue
 - b) Shirts / tops must have a collar
 - c) Shirts / tops may have long or short sleeves
 - d) No logos / emblems
 - e) Shirts / tops must be tucked in
- 3) The following regulations will be followed for pants/ skirts/ shorts/ skorts/ jumpers:
 - a) Pants/ skirts/ shorts/ skorts/ jumpers may be khaki or navy blue
 - b) No logos / emblems
 - c) A belt must be worn if there are belt loops
- 4) No warm up pants, sweat pants, wind pants, or denim of any color
- 5) Jacket, sweater, or coat that is to be worn all day must be navy or white and should be free of logos.
